Everyday 850,000 law enforcement officers from the United States and Canada work to fulfill this mission. Sometimes these officers make the ultimate sacrifice and are tragically killed in the line of duty.

- In 2006, 145 officers from the United States and five from Canada were lost in the line of duty
- Over 5000 law enforcement agencies have lost officers
- The average age of these officers is just 37-years-old
- Many leave young families behind

With a heartfelt desire to help the families of these brave men and women; and as a way to give back to the law enforcement community, TASER International established the TASER Foundation as a 501(c)3 non-profit organization in November 2004.

As of October 2007 the TASER Foundation has awarded over 1.5 million dollars in direct financial assistance to more than 400 families.

TASER International bears all the administrative costs of the Foundation so that 100 percent of all donations are distributed directly to the families of fallen officers.

Mission: To honor the service and sacrifice of local and federal law enforcement officers from the United States and Canada killed in the line of duty by providing financial and educational support to their families.

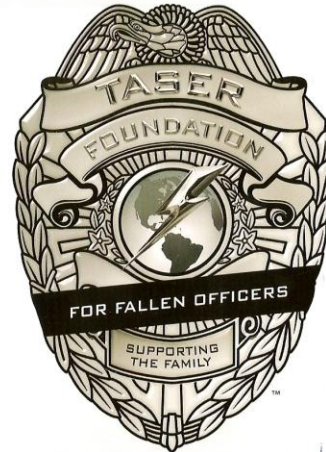

HONORING THE SERVICE AND SACRIFICE OF FALLEN OFFICERS

The TASER FOUNDATION for Fallen Officers is a means to support the law enforcement community by providing financial and education support to the families of sworn law enforcement personnel lost in the line of duty from the United States and Canada.

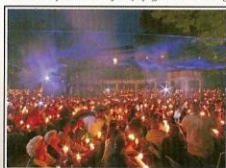
The Foundation receives support from TASER International, Inc. and donations from private and corporate donors. In addition, TASER International bears all administrative costs for the Foundation so that 100% of all donations directly benefit the families of fallen officers.

The TASER FOUNDATION focuses on providing immediate support to the families and can issue a grant within 24 hours of receipt of the completed application. The funds may be used for what ever the families' may need.

In addition, the TASER FOUNDATION in partnership with the American Public University has created the Living the Legacy Scholarships to provide online educational opportunities to immediate family members. WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

The TASER FOUNDATION provides support to the families of those who gave their lives while protecting our communities. The immediate family (spouse and/or dependents) of a sworn law enforcement officer whose life was lost in the line of duty is eligible for benefits. In order to qualify, the immediate cause of a loss of life must be duty related and have occurred since August 1, 2004. Loss of life from a pre-existing medical condition does not qualify.
